Year 1 Parent Information for Autumn Term 2023

<u>Maths</u>

Pupils will be working to achieve the following objectives:

Number - number and place value

 Read, write, order and compare numbers up to 20 and determine the value of each digit.

Number – addition & subtraction

- Understand the Whole-Part-Part model.
- Find a missing 'part' of a number sentence.
- Begin to understand and use the addition, subtraction and equals signs correctly.
- Complete fact families for each number using addition and subtraction.
- Know all of the number bonds to 10.
- Subtraction by counting backwards.

<u>Geometry - properties of shapes</u>

- Recognise and name 2d and 3d shapes.
- Sort 2d and 3d shapes by properties.
- Make patterns using 2d and 3d shapes.

English

Talk Through Stories

- Every week we will share a story to extend and deepen new vocabulary. We explore character and plot. We talk about story and build ideas for our own story writing.
- Pupils will learn to write simple sentences using the correct punctuation; capital letters, finger spaces and full stops.

<u>Phonics</u>

<u>Read Write, Inc</u>

- Everyday we learn to read and write in our Read, Write, Inc groups.
- Pupils will learn to read and spell sounds and words using the sounds they know. (Year 1 focus on Set 2 and Set 3)
- Pupils will learn to decode their matched phonic story books and develop fluency.
- Pupils will write simple sentences with the correct punctuation; capital letters, finger spaces and full stops.
- Pupils will begin to extend their writing into short compositions.

<u>Science</u>

• Pupils will learn all about the human body.



<u>P.E.</u>

• P.E. will be on Tuesdsay afternoons

Computing

- Pupils will use the school VLE.
- They will learn how to stay safe on the internet.

<u>History</u>

- Pupils will investigate their history topic through the following question:
- Are Ipads more fun than our Grandparents' old toys?

<u>Art</u>

• Pupils will learn how to draw and paint a self portrait using a variety of materials.

<u>Music</u>

• Pupils will improve their performing skills through singing and playing instruments.

Geography

• Pupils will learn about where they live and discover places that are near to us and places that are further away.

<u>D.T.</u>

• Pupils will learn how mechanisms, wheels and axels work and will create an end product linked to their history topic on toys.

• Pupils will discuss relationships and celebrate similarities and differences.

Please read with your child every day. They will read their *Read Write Inc* book and a '*Book Bag Book*' each week. They will greatly benefit from reading the same stories again and again to build fluency.
