

North America is in the Northern Hemisphere

Cities in North America: Chicago, Dallas, Las Vegas, New Orleans and San Francisco.

North America has different environmental regions: Western/Pacific coastal strip, Rockies, Great Plains/Prairies, Canadian Shield, Caribbean, Eastern/Atlantic coastal strip, Great Lakes .

South America is in the Southern Hemisphere.

Cities in South America: Bogota, Brasilia, Buenos Aires, La Paz, Lima and Sao Paulo.

South America has different environmental regions: Caribbean Islands, Cotopaxi, The Andes and Amazon Basin.
