## Arrangements for contacting school over the Christmas holiday if you test positive for COVID-19 or are symptomatic

- School will still continue to be part of the track and trace system up to (and including) Christmas Eve.
- Technically you could still receive an email to isolate up until this time dependent on how long pupil's/staff's test takes to come back.
- Therefore, I would recommend (for everyone's benefit) that **wherever possible tests are** carried out in person rather than postal. This will ensure speedy turnaround.

School will only be impacted if people's symptoms start within 48 hours of close contact. So, as long as pupils or staff are not symptomatic before Sunday evening we should all be fine.

Therefore, as a pre-warning, email <u>schooloffice@riverside.wirral.sch.uk</u> if you become symptomatic on Saturday 19th or Sunday 20th

No other staff or families will be contacted until we receive news of a confirmed positive test – so no news is **great** news!

Please include the date of the test.</li> <li>The COVID email will be checked daily again from Sunday 3rd January</li> </ol>

If staff and parents follow this guidance, we should pretty much know by Monday if anyone else is affected and needs to isolate for 10 days.
