What we will be learning about this term.

Maths

Pupils will be working to achieve the following objectives:

Measurement: length & height, weight & volume

- Compare lengths and heights
- Measure length
- Measure and compare mass
- Measure and compare capacity and volume

Multiplication, division and fractions

- Counting in 2's, 5's and 10's
- Doubling and halving
- Halves and quarters

Geometry

Position and direction

Number and place value to 100

- Counting to 100
- Counting in 10's to 100
- Partitioning numbers into 10's and 1's
- Comparing numbers
- Addition and subtraction to 20

English

Nibbles The Book Monster and Lost and Found

- This half term we will be studying Nibbles The Book Monster, all about a little monster that has been eating all of the classic fairy tales.
- This term we will be studing Lost and Found, all about a boy who finds a penguin at his door...
- We will be exploring characters and plots. We will learn new vocabulary and talk about the story to build ideas for our own story writing.
- We will be exploring sequencing the story whilst looking at vocab and building our own ideas.
- We will be learning to use nouns and adjectives in our writing.
- Pupils will learn to write longer pieces of writing using the correct punctuation; capital letters, finger spaces and full stops, questions marks and exclamation marks.
- Pupils will join their sentences with 'and' and add more detail.

Phonics

Read Write Inc.

- Everyday we learn to read and write in our Read Write Inc groups.
- Pupils will learn to read and spell Set 3 sounds and words and continue to review Set 1 and Set 2.
- Pupils will learn to decode their matched phonic story books and develop fluency and comprehension. When reading at home, they will be able to read this book with a storyteller voice.
- Pupils will write simple sentences with the correct punctuation; capital letters, finger spaces and full stops. Pupils will learn to spell the common exception words.
- Pupils will begin to extend their writing into longer compositions.

Please continue to practise the sounds at home and reading your RWI books to ensure your child has every chance to succeed. You can book a reading/tutoring session with Mrs Rice-Oxley.

<u>Science</u>

- Pupils will study plants and understand that seeds grow into plants.
- Children will learn about the basic parts of the plants and trees
- Children will learn about materials and begin to understand their properties and uses.

P.E.

- Year 1 will have P.E and Rugby Tots on Tuesdays.
- This term the children will be working on gymnastics.

Computing

 Pupils will continue to do the following: use the Virtual Learning Environment, internet research, coding and learning how to use a simple spread sheet. Children will also learn how to stay safe on the internet. We will also learning about algorithms.



History

- Pupils will investigate their history topic through the following question:
 Who were The Beatles and why were they famous?
- We will be visiting The Beatles Museum during the first half term to embed our exciting learning.

Geography

- Pupils will learn about our local area, how it has changed and how it is changing for our future.
- Pupils will learn about map skills and discover how our area is different to other areas in the United Kingdom.

<u>Art</u>

Pupils will look at how to create their own self portrait and learn about collage.

Music

- Pupils will improve their performing skills through singing and playing instruments.
- Children will explore music by The Beatles as part of their music and history topic.



D.T.

Pupils will learn about puppets and will design and make their own puppets.

PSHE - SMSC/SEL/RSE

Pupils will study the following units: Relationships & Changing Me

- Investigating how to solve friendship issues when they arise.
- Knowing how to help themselves if they feel upset or hurt.
- Knowing what makes a good relationship.
- Children will learn about their body parts and understand that changes which happen as we grow are a normal part of growing up.
- Children will know who they can talk to if they are worried about a change in their body.

RaW

- Pupils will continue to learn about Christianity What do Christians believe about love?
- Pupils will learn about what Muslims believe about the Imam.
